Submit the completed application; payment in the form of a personal check, money order, or cashier's check; and proof of eligibility to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles at the following address:

The specialty plate fee is \$40 per year in addition to your annual registration fee. **Do not mail cash**. Fee is not refundable. To apply for or renew this qualifying plate, you must:

- be an official who is appointed as an Honorary Consul by a foreign government.
- be the owner of the motor vehicle described below.
- attach a copy of your unexpired Consular Identification Card issued by the United States Department of State.

License plates may be issued to passenger cars and trucks with a gross vehicle weight of 10,000 lbs. or less. Contact the Special Plates Unit at (512) 374-5010 if you have any questions.
