## Instructions

Submit completed application, payment in the form of a personal check, money order or cashier's check, and any required attachments to your local county tax assessor-collector's office. **Do not mail cash.** The specialty plate fee is \$30 or \$40 per year, as indicated below, in addition to the annual registration fee. License plates may be personalized for an additional \$40 fee, make your selection on page 2.

**Specialty plate fee will not be refunded once application is submitted.** When the specialty plate is issued, additional fees may be collected to match the expiration date for both the specialty plate and the vehicle registration. If you place your order online or by mail, contact your county tax assessor-collector's office in three weeks to verify your plate is ready.

Texas title and vehicle registration must be in your name. If you recently filed an application for title, attach a copy of the title application (VTR-500 RTS) receipt. If the plate is to be registered to a vehicle that is not titled in your name, attach a statement to this application stating that you have legal right of possession and control of this vehicle at all times. Submit a separate application for each vehicle. Attach a copy of the lease agreement if the vehicle is leased. Vehicle must be for personal use only. Contact your county tax assessor-collector if you have additional questions.

- A selection that has already been issued; is deemed offensive, or conflicts with the regular license plate numbering system cannot be approved.
- In the blocks below, describe each of your selected personalized letters, numbers, and/or symbols. The available symbols take up the space of one letter and include: a period, a dash, a blank space, a Texas silhouette (use an asterisk (\*)), a heart (use an "at" mark (@)) and a star (use an ampersand (&)).
- Because of the size of the designs, passenger car and truck plates may be personalized with up to five characters, the *Alamo* and the *Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo* plates may be personalized with up to six characters.
- Because of the size of the designs, motorcycle and moped plates may be personalized with up to four (4) characters; the *Alamo* motorcycle plate may be personalized with up to five characters.
- You are not required to use all the spaces provided.
- The International Symbol of Access (ISA)  counts as two (2) characters and will be located at the beginning of the plate number. If you are disabled and applying for personalized specialty plates, the plate may consist of only three characters (or two, if for a motorcycle/moped). Use a percent sign (%) to indicate the International Symbol of Access.

To display the International Symbol of Access (ISA)  on your license plate, you must attach a signed Form VTR-214 to this application to show your eligibility for the International Symbol of Access. The ISA is available for vehicles 18,000 lbs. or less. Contact your county tax assessor-collector's office for more information.
