- Serve as a historical reference regarding the technical changes made to Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) applications.

#### Release at A Glance

This document describes new features, enhancements and defect corrections to the RTS 7.2.0 and Remote Sticker Printing System (RSPS) 2.7.0. The visible enhancements in this release include:

- Elimination of Tonnage
- Lienholder ID Required
- Rights of Survivorship on DTA
- ♦ RTS Default Printer Event
- Admin Table Updates
- My Plates

### The 7.2.0 statewide release date is June 17, 2013.

# **Important Reminders**

◆ Flash Drive Updates to support the latest plate release.



#### Flash Drive Updates to Laptops

In this release, several new plates are now available in RSPS, so be sure to update the subcontractor laptops with the latest version of RTS.

Subcontractors not implemented with WebSub should export existing transactions to a flash drive before updating the laptop so these transactions are not lost.

If you do not export before updating the laptop, the data could become corrupt which may result in having to enter these transactions manually.

# Elimination of Tonnage

#### Overview

In this release, tonnage <u>is no longer required</u> for titling and registration of trucks. Elimination of tonnage will occur in stages. The following is an overview of the tonnage changes and the associated implementation dates:

#### As of 06/17/2013:

- ◆ Tonnage is no longer a factor in determining eligibility for license plates. Disabled Person license plates, Specialty plates, including military plates with the International Symbol of Access (ISA) and Disabled Veteran (DV) plates will only be available for vehicles with gross weight of 18,000 lbs. or less.
- ◆ Tonnage is no longer a factor in the calculation of the Diesel Fee. The Diesel Fee will be calculated on vehicles with a gross weight of 18,001 lbs. or more (but only on registrations with a Reg Effective Date of at least 08/01/2013, such as July 2013 expirations and later).
- Tonnage is no longer a factor in determining if a vehicle is exempt from the odometer disclosure requirements. Vehicles with a gross weight of 16,001 lbs. or more will be exempt from the odometer requirements.
- Trucks up to 10,000 lbs. gross weight are Plate to Owner eligible.
- ◆ Tonnage is no longer used to determine eligibility for the issuance of a Combination license plate. A Combination license plate can be issued to a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 lbs. used in combination with a semitrailer with a gross weight of more than 6,000 lbs. A combination of vehicles may not be registered for a combined gross weight of less than 18,000 lbs.
- Tonnage is no longer printed on receipt and title documents.

#### As of 08/01/2013:

- RTS Point of Sale (POS) no longer requires input of tonnage.
- POS no longer has weight edits based upon tonnage.
- Tonnage is no longer displayed on screens.




#### **Disabled Person and Disabled Veteran Plates**

Disabled Person license plates and Specialty license plates, including Military with the ISA and DV license plates are no longer eligible to be displayed on vehicles with a gross weight of 18,001 lbs. or more. Registrants with this plate/vehicle combination **will not** be able to renew their registration with their current license plate.

If a clerk tries to renew a registration with Disabled Person license plate or Specialty license plate, including Military with the ISA or DV license plates for a vehicle with a gross weight of 18,001 lbs. or more a message will be presented.



A reminder message will appear when ordering Specialty license plates, including Military with the ISA or DV plates.





If a customer with a Disabled Person license plate or Specialty license plate, including Military with the ISA or DV license plate for a vehicle with a gross weight of 18,001 or more, tries to renew their vehicle online, they will be presented with the following message: Your Vehicle Does Not Qualify for Online Registration Renewal. Contact Your County Tax Office or Vehicle Title Registration (VTR) Headquarters at 512-465-3000 or toll-free 1-888-DMVGOTX(368-4689) for Further Assistance.


#### **Diesel Fee Calculation**

Tonnage will no longer be used in Diesel Fee calculations; fees will be based on gross weight. A Diesel Fee will be charged on diesel-fueled trucks with a gross weight of 18,001 lbs. or more.

### **Tonnage on RTS screens**

The RTS screens will no longer display tonnage. Tonnage will no longer be used in weight edits or validations; instead, it will be based on gross weight (empty weight + carrying capacity = gross weight).



# **TAC Office Considerations...**

- 1. The July 2013 registration renewal notices are the first to reflect the changes based on elimination of tonnage.
- Vehicles with a Disabled Person license plate, Specialty or Military license plate with the ISA
  or a DV license plate with a gross weight of 18,001 lbs. or more <u>will not</u> get a renewal
  notice but will receive a letter explaining what must be done to renew the registration.

# Lienholder ID Required


#### Overview

A Lienholder ID will be required to be entered when selecting "Certified" and "ETitle" lienholders. The drop down box will no longer be available. A **Green** search button has been added to the right of the 1<sup>st</sup> Id box in the Lien Entry (TTL035) screen.

**NOTE**: Your "Local" lienholders list will not be impacted by these changes; they will continue to work the same way.


#### **Certified Lienholder**

When processing a title transaction with a certified lienholder, select the certified button at the top right hand corner, enter the lienholder's ID in the 1<sup>st</sup> Id box, click on the green search button and the lienholder information will auto-populate.



#### **ETitle Lienholder**

When processing a title with an eTitle lienholder ID number, select the eTitle button at the top right hand corner, enter the lienholder's ID, click the green search button and the lienholder information will auto-populate.





The Certified Lienholder Report is located under Local Options, where a user can find a certified or eTitle lienholder ID number sorting by ID or name.




# **Rights of Survivorship on DTA**

#### Overview


The Rights of Survivorship (ROS) remark is now available for Dealer Title Applications (DTA). Dealers can now enter up to two names or select Mulitiple Survivors when there are more than two survivors who enter into the ROS Agreement. RTS will allow the entry of up to 30 characters per name, however, only the first 20 characters will print on the Title. When Multiple Survivors is selected, the names do not appear in the system; however, the remark **Multiple Survivors** displays in the remarks box.

If the ROS indicator is selected, at least one name must be entered in the field or Multiple Survivors must be checked.

Use the **Reset** button to delete, re-enter or select another survivorship option.



#### **TAC Office Considerations...**

- 1. The Survivorship Rights indicator is not available for the following: RPO, Salvage, Non-Repairable and Non-Titled.
- 2. There are no changes to the Form 130-U or VTR-122 or current Rights of Survivorship rules.
- 3. Dealers that are using the RSPS <u>need to</u> do the flash drive updates.

# **RTS Default Printer Event**

#### Overview

The RTS Default Printer is a new event under Miscellaneous. Once the RTS Default Printer has been set, the printer will print for RTS and **any user** on that workstation. If the RTS Default Printer has not been set, then the **current** user's Windows Default Printer will continue to be the printer.




### How to Set a RTS Default Printer.

- 1. Click on Miscellaneous.
- 2. Select Set RTS Default Printer.



The RTS Default Printer screen (CTL012) will display the printer.


- 3. Select the Printer.

# **TAC Office Considerations...**

- 1. Dealers that are using the RSPS <u>need to</u> do the flash drive updates.
  - Travel trailers that are eligible for Classic Travel Trailer license plates (25 years old or older) are <u>exempt</u> from the delinquent transfer penalty.
  - County Tax offices can now keep multiple copies of Void Reports. Void Reports are no longer being over written with the next void transaction and up to 7 Void Reports can be maintained for a workstation.
