Attachment to Form LF001

This affirmation should accompany the Application for General Distinguishing Number (Independent Dealers), Form LF001. Additionally, if you do not currently have a Converter License, you must apply for one.

A mobility motor vehicle is defined as a motor vehicle that is designed and equipped to transport a person with a disability and that:

- (A) has a chassis that contains:
(1) a permanently lowered floor or lowered frame; or
(2) a permanently raised roof and raised door;
(B) contains at least one of the following:
(1) an electronic or mechanical wheelchair, scooter, or platform lift that enables a person to enter or exit the vehicle while occupying a wheelchair or scooter;
(2) an electronic or mechanical wheelchair ramp; or
(3) a system to secure a wheelchair or scooter to allow for a person to be safely transported while occupying the wheelchair or scooter; and
(C) is installed as an integral part or permanent attachment to the motor vehicle's chassis.
