At a Glance

This release of e-Tag contains a number of enhancements to improve your user experience. These include:

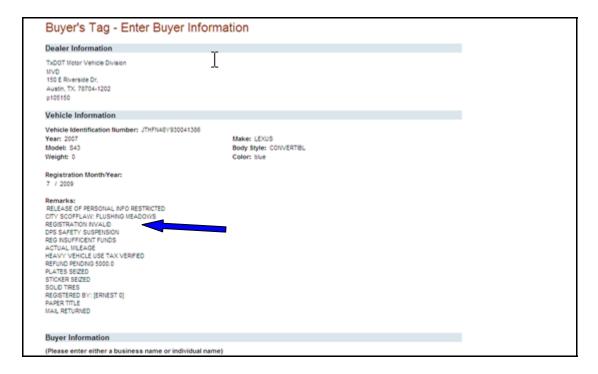
- Registration Invalid Remark-Buyer's Tag
- Creating New User Accounts-Dealer License Number
- Creating New User Accounts- Last and First Name

Registration Invalid Remark-Buyer's Tag

When e-Tag issues a Buyer's Tag for a vehicle that has a remark, **Registration Invalid**, the system now displays **00/00** for the **Registration Month/Year**

If the vehicle has an invalid registration remark, the remark now appears in the following locations:

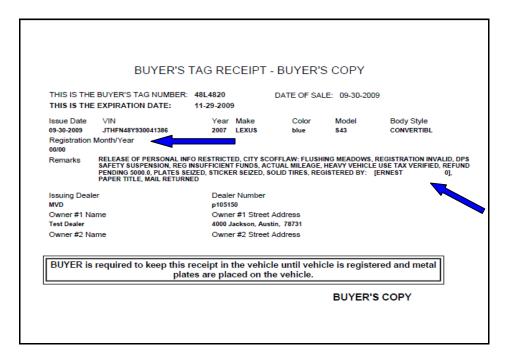
- Buyer's Tag- Enter Buyer Information screen (shown below)
- Buyer's Tag- Confirmation Tag Information screen

If the vehicle has an invalid registration remark, the **00/00** for **Registration Month/Year** now appears in the following locations,

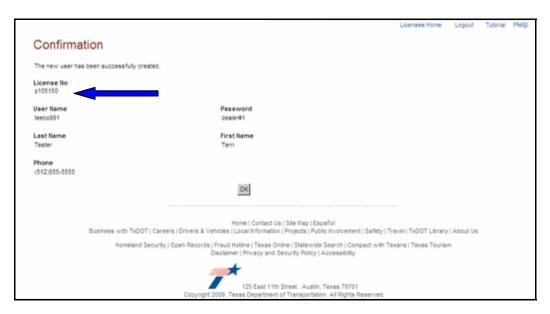
- Buyer's Tag Receipt-Dealer's Copy
- Buyer's Tag Receipt-Buyer's Copy (shown below)



Creating New User Accounts- Dealer License Number

Confirmation Page

When a vehicle dealer creates a new user account, the confirmation screen now appears with the dealer license number as shown below.

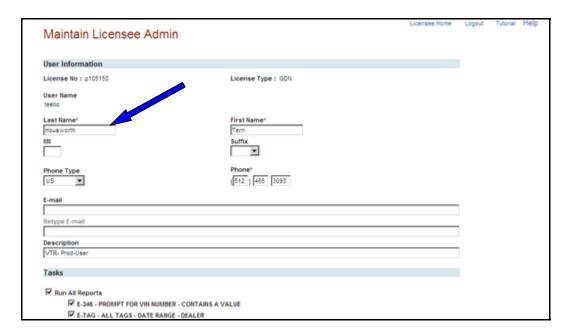

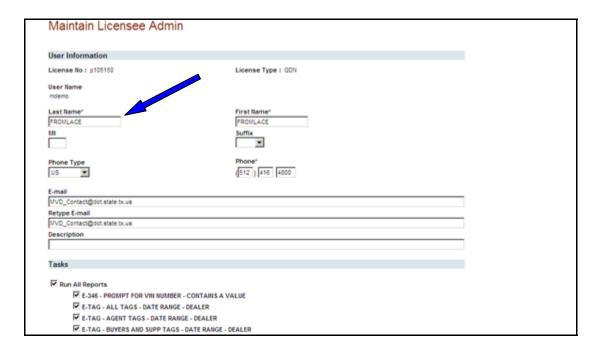
Creating New User Accounts- Last and First name

Maintain Licensee Administrator-User Information Page

When new accounts load into the e-Tag V21 database, the users last and first name now displays on the Maintain Licensee Admin screen under User Information as shown below.



All accounts that were previously set-up in the e-Tag database continue to show FROMLACE as their first and last name until updated by the Manage License Administrator.
