The Motor Carrier Division, Permits section is required to have weights verified on loads that exceed 500,000lbs. TxDMV reserves the right to require verification of weights on any load the Department deem necessary.

In order for the Super Heavy Permit to be processed, the weight must be certified by a weighing agent. The weight or gauge reading must be certified by one of the following:

- ◆ License and weight inspector of the Department of Public Safety,
- ◆ A highway patrol officer,
- ◆ A sheriff or sheriff's deputy,
- ◆ A municipal police officer,
- ◆ A police officer certified under Section 644.101 in the Texas Transportation Code,
- ◆ A constable or deputy constable designated under Section 621.4015 in the Texas Transportation Code, or
- ◆ Any TxDOT or TxDMV personnel that is identified and approved by MCD OS/OW Permit Office.

Note to Certifying Agent: Attached are directions from the TxDOT Bridge Division or the TxDOT approved outside engineer as to which axles are required to be weighed. It is the discretion of the certifying agent to list weight of each tire load or weight per axle, unless it is specifically outlined in the request from TxDOT or outside engineer.
