These Release Notes contain information about new features, enhancements, and reported issues resolved in this release of eLICENSING.


## eLICENSING Overview

eLICENSING is an online self-service hub for all motor vehicle dealers, salvage dealers, and industry licensees operating in Texas. Dealers and licensees can access licensing information, submit license applications and payments, and track the progress of submitted applications. Members of the public as well as tax assessor-collectors may use eLICENSING to file complaints against dealers.

**LACE-10973:** Dealer Temporary Plate - New Appl-Add new Metal Temp Plates/Dealer Temporary Plate to the eLICENSE application processes

**LACE-11098:** HB 718 - Increase Plate field size in RTS Batch file

**LACE-11177:** Mailing address on packing list include DBA also.

**LACE-11010:** Separate Packing Slips Needed for a combined order of both Standard and Temp Plates.

## Business Reported Issues

- LACE-10973 Dealer Temporary Plates - New Appl-Add new Metal Temp Plates/Blue Plates to the eLICENSE application processes**
- Provides FRN & GDN Dealers the ability to order the new Dealer Temporary plates through the New License application so that the Dealer Temporary plates will be available for use to new license holders on July 1st of 2025. The new Dealer Temporary plates will replace the Vehicle-Specific and Agent-Specific Dealer Temporary Tags.
- LACE-11098 HB 718 - Increase Plate field size in RTS Batch file**
- The plate size field in the daily run RTS batch file was increased to accommodate the 8 characters needed for the Dealer Temporary Plates.
- LACE-11177 Add the DBA to the physical mailing address**
- The Dealer's DBA(s) was added to the physical address on the packing slip.
- LACE-11010 Separate Packing Slips Needed for a combined order of both Standard and Temp Plates.**
- Separate packing slips are created for each metal plate type even when the dealer places a combination order of Standard and Temporary plates.
