eLICENSING is an online self-service hub for all motor vehicle dealers, salvage dealers, and industry licensees operating in Texas. Dealers and licensee can access licensing information, submit license applications and payments, and track the progress of submitted applications. Members of the public as well as tax assessor-collectors may use eLICENSING to file complaints against dealers.

Summary of Business Reported Issues

MVD

- LACE-11240** - Need to make the number of vehicles sold data field "read only" in a plate app and renewal app
- LACE-11294** - Change GDN type to retail or wholesale Amendment: Plates with Cancel option Needs to be Updated to "Cancelled"
- LACE-11317** - APA Expired plate dates- Seems the code used to calculate the future exp date does not consider leap year.
- LACE-11331** - HB718: Motorcycle standard plate app requiring number of vehicles sold when the requested number of plates is less than the plate limit
- LACE-11343** - Wholesale GDN requested more than maximum number of plates did not have a hard stop
- LACE-11344** - Wholesale GDN Renewal App has wrong error message when more plates requested is allowed
- LACE-11369** - LACE-10970 Defect - Locations with Second Street Address Change

Business Reported Issues

LACE-11240 - Updates to "Quantity of Vehicles Sold in the Last 12 Months" Field

Description: On plate and renewal applications, the system now shows the "Quantity of Vehicles Sold in the Last 12 Months" field as enabled only if the number of plates requested is greater than the quantity shown in the "Standard or Temp Dealer Plate Limit Without Waiver" fields, so that the waiver is correctly triggered when requesting additional plates.

LACE-11294 – Update to Plate Inventory Status on Change GDN Type to Retail or Wholesale Amendment

Description: On Change GDN Type to Retail or Wholesale Amendment, the current Plate Inventory status of "Cancel", was updated to "Cancelled" for consistency between application types.

LACE-11317 - APA Expired Plate Dates Calculation

Description: The expiration date calculations for APA Expired plates were adjusted to consider a leap year for future date calculations.

LACE-11331 - Removal of Error Message on Motorcycle Standard Plate Applications

Description: The erroneous error message on standard motorcycle plate applications requiring the number of vehicles sold when the requested number of plates is less than the plate limit was removed.

LACE-11343 – Addition of Hard Stop for Wholesale GDN Maximum Standard Dealer Plate Limit

Description: The system now makes a hard stop with an error when a wholesale GDN application requests more than two standard dealer plates.

LACE-11344 – Correction of Error Message on Wholesale GDN Renewal Applications

Description: The correct error message is now shown on a renewal application when a wholesale GDN application request more plates than what is allowable under current Board rule.

LACE-11369 – Secure Plate Storage Attachment for Location Changes with Second Street Address Change

Description: The secure plate storage attachment is now correctly populating when the second street address (suite #, building #, etc.) is changed via a location amendment application.
