The intended audience of this document are users of webDEALER.






#### Enhancements in Release 24.1

#### **Vehicle License Plate Validations at Time of Assignment**

Validations have been introduced at the time of vehicle license plate assignment in webDEALER to prevent the issuance of duplicate license plates and to minimize inventory tracking issues.

When the county tax assessor-collector office or dealer deputies with allocated license plates are assigning license plates to a vehicle in webDEALER, they may encounter an error or warning message notifying them of a possible discrepancy with the license plates they are attempting to assign.


If the provided plate number has previously been issued, the following error message displays and the county tax assessor-collector office or dealer deputy is not able to continue. A new license plate number must be assigned.








If the provided plate number has been assigned to a different office, the following error message displays and the processing county tax assessor-collector office is not able to continue. A new license plate number must be assigned.



#### **Limit Plate Number Field to 7 Characters**

The "Plate Number" field of the "Plate and Sticker Information" page in webDEALER has been limited to 7 alpha-numeric characters.








## Removal of Inspection Verification for Trailers/Travel Trailers When Creating Buyer Tags

When creating a buyer tag in eTAG for any trailer or travel trailer, regardless of weight, the system will no longer require a current passing vehicle inspection. Users will no longer receive a "No current inspection was found for this vehicle. Do you want to continue?" message on the Buyer Tag – VIN Search page in eTAG.



#### **Travel Trailer Vehicle Class Correction**

A previous issue prevented users from assigning the appropriate license plate to a travel trailer due to the vehicle class being recorded incorrectly in the system as a trailer. This issue has now been resolved as part of this release.
