This document describes the latest software changes made to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) webDEALER software application.

Scope

The scope of this is to identify recent software changes to the webDEALER application as documented in the latest webDEALER User Guides. This document does not provide step-by-step instructions on how to use webDEALER.

Audience

The intended audience of this document is users of webDEALER.





Enhancements in Release 26.1

Assignment of converter plates by Converter dealers

Converter dealers can now assign converter plates via ePLATE as well as perform various supporting and associated actions. The Converter dealer ePLATE home screen now includes:


- A running count of active converter plate assignments
- A "Plates" dropdown menu which enables:
 - o Plate assignment
 - The changing of an assigned operator
 - o Removal of a plate assignment
 - Ability to reprint a plate assignment receipt
- A reporting tool related to converter plate assignments







A converter plate assignment can be initiated by selecting the "Converter Plate Assignment" option in the Plates drop down menu and entering the VIN associated with the plate assignment.




After which, the user will need to provide all required vehicle information, select a plate to assign, and select the Assign Plate button. The vehicle information required includes:


- Year
- Make
- Model
- Body Style
- Major Color








A user can then print the plate assignment receipt by selecting the "Print Receipt" button.








If a user needs to reprint a plate assignment receipt, they can navigate to the Reprint Plate Receipt option in the Plates drop down menu and search via plate number, VIN, or operator name.




If a user needs to change the assigned operator, they can navigate to the Change Operator option in the Plates drop down menu and search via VIN or plate number.








They can then update the Operator Name and select the "Update Operator" button.




If a user needs to remove a converter plate assignment, they can navigate to the Remove Assignment option in the Plates drop down menu and search via VIN or plate number.



They can then remove the converter plate assignment by selecting the "Remove Association" button.













If a user needs to create a report regarding converter plate assignments, they can navigate to the Reports tab and select Converter Plate Report from the provided drop down menu, enter all required information, select reporting data, and select the Export button.



Assignment of dealer plates by Wholesale dealers

Wholesale dealers can now assign dealer plates via ePLATE as well as perform various supporting and associated actions. The Wholesale dealer ePLATE home screen includes:


- A running count of active dealer plate assignments
- A "Plates" dropdown menu which enables:
 - Dealer plate assignment
 - The changing of an assigned operator
 - o Removal of a plate assignment
 - o Ability to reprint a plate assignment receipt
- A reporting tool related to dealer plate assignments







A dealer plate assignment can be initiated by selecting the "Dealer Plate Assignment" option in the Plates drop down menu and entering the VIN associated with the plate assignment.




After which, the user will need to provide all required vehicle information, select a plate to assign, and select the Assign Plate button. The vehicle information required includes:


- Year

- Major Color








A user can then print the plate assignment receipt by selecting the "Print Receipt" button.






After confirming the search result details, a reprint can be initiated by selecting the "Reprint Receipt" button.








If a user needs to change the assigned operator, they can navigate to the Change Operator option in the Plates drop down menu and search via VIN or plate number.




They can then update the Operator Name and select the "Update Operator" button.








If a user needs to remove a dealer plate assignment, they can navigate to the Remove Assignment option in the Plates drop down menu and search via VIN or plate number.




They can then remove the dealer plate assignment by selecting the "Remove Association" button.






Removal of tag related information from ePLATE

The following tag related information has been removed from ePLATE:


- Home page related tag activity information

Removal of Trailer/Semitrailer apportioned registration from the ePLATE plate assignment process








Enabling the plate assignment process in ePLATE for VINs that are less than 17 characters and a model year of 1980 or older

A system limitation prevented dealers from completing ePLATE license plate assignments for vehicles with VINs under 17 characters, with a model year of 1980 or older. This issue has been resolved. After entering a VIN which is less than 17 characters, the dealer will be asked to enter the vehicles model year. If the model year entered is 1980 or older, ePLATE will prompt the user to confirm if they would like to continue.







Enabling the titling of off-highway vehicles

A system limitation resulted in dealers encountering the below error message when attempting to title off-highway vehicles in webDEALER. This issue has been resolved, and dealers will not receive the following error message on the Vehicle Information page for off-highway vehicles.



Updates to the ePLATE internet down receipt plate assignment process error messages

When processing a license plate assignment for an issued Internet Down Receipt, the error message below will display for certain NMVTIS brands preventing the permanent plate assignment.



No further processing is available. For additional vehicle information, please go to Title Check on the TxDMV website to obtain a vehicle title history through the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS) database.

When processing a plate assignment for an Internet Down Receipt that has been issued, the error messages below will display if the vehicle has an existing salvage or non-repairable Texas title.



A plate cannot be assigned since the following remarks exist on the title record [[12/30/2022], SALV VEHICLE TITLE ISSUED, EVIDENCE SURR. BY SALVAGE YARD] for VIN: (5829)



A plate cannot be assigned since the following remarks exist on the title record [[02/24/2013], NONREPAIRABLE VEHICLE TITLE ISSUED] for VIN: (5829)

If any of the above error messages appear, the vehicle cannot be operated on public roads unless it was eligible to be rebuilt and issued a rebuilt salvage title.
