Law Enforcement Requestor Responsibilities

TxDMV's review of this form must be completed before information is provided by TxDMV's Law Enforcement Analyst Section. In order to avoid interruptions in the service agreement, the requestor must submit a new form before the expiration of 12 months from the date that TxDMV sends notice of vetting approval.

TxDMV may request information from you regarding compliance with Transportation Code Chapter 730, agency rules, or other law that applies to disclosed personal or confidential information. You are required to provide the requested information not later than the fifth business day after TxDMV submits the request, unless TxDMV extends the deadline.

Requestors are responsible for notifying TxDMV whether their request is being made under Transportation Code §730.007(a)(2)(A) (relating to any law enforcement agency function) or §730.007(d) (relating to preventing, detecting, or protecting against personal identity theft or other acts of fraud).

Secondary dissemination, or redisclosure, is permissible only when authorized for a specific purpose by state and federal laws. The recipient of personal or confidential information from TxDMV is required to notify each person to whom they redisclose information that they also cannot redisclose the personal or confidential information to someone who is not authorized to receive it under state and federal law.
