**REGISTRATION AND TITLE SYSTEMS (RTS):** RTS provides a uniform automated system for county tax offices to use in the registration and titling of vehicles. In FY 2020, there were approximately **3,242** workstations at **550** sites. There were **82,914,495** motor vehicle records (**43,750,860** of which were archival records) in the automated file in FY 2020. Law enforcement made **78,407,476** system inquiries for an average of **149** requests per minute in FY 2020. The total collections from vehicle registration and title fees as well as motor vehicle sales tax was **\$6,743,213,930** in FY 2020.

REGIONAL SERVICE CENTERS: Abilene, Amarillo, Austin, Beaumont, Corpus Christi, Dallas - Carrollton, El Paso, Fort Worth - Arlington, Houston, Longview, Lubbock, Odessa, Pharr, San Antonio, Waco and Wichita Falls.
