Instructions

Submit the completed application, payment in the form of a personal check, money order or cashier's check to your local county tax assessor-collector's office. **Do not mail cash**. There is no specialty plate fee; however, the annual registration and other applicable fees must be paid.

One Cotton License Plate may be issued per vehicle if the eligibility requirements below are met.

If you order by mail, contact your county tax assessor-collector's office in three weeks to verify your plate is ready. Contact your county tax assessor-collector if you have questions.

Eligibility Requirements

A cotton vehicle license plate may only be issued to a single motor vehicle to transport chile pepper modules, seed cotton, cotton, cotton burrs, or equipment used to transport or process chile peppers or cotton, and is not more than 10 feet in width; 48 feet in length; or 14 feet, 6 inches in height.

Transportation Code, Section 622.953, requires the overall gross weight of a single motor vehicle used to transport seed cotton, or equipment used to transport seed cotton, **not exceed 64,000 lbs.**, and also requires the overall gross weight of a single motor vehicle used to transport chile pepper modules, or equipment used to transport chile pepper modules, **not exceed 54,000 lbs.**
